## INTRODUCTION

The Powerful Young Project (PYP) Children's Day event held on the 1st of June, 2019 at Christian Council School, W Close, 5th Avenue, Festac Town, Lagos, Nigeria. This event was in collaboration with Angel's Arm, a charity organization focused on bringing social relief to the underprivileged in Nigeria.

The event started at exactly 10:00am and ended at 5pm with over 150 students in attendance, PYP volunteers and some parents / guardians who accompanied their child / ward to the event.

## ABOUT THE EVENT

It was tagged: *Let's Have Fun Giving Back*, a theme chosen in order to inculcate in the children a sense of social responsibility. At this event, the children engaged in fun and informative games and activities centred around environmental sustainability.

Opening prayer was said after receiving Greenhill Recycling team thereafter a brief introduction of all volunteers and the event flow was done.

### *Greenhill Recycling*

Mr Hilary Kadiri and his crew (Onanuga Temitope, Jacob Oluchi and Osi Ugheoke) mounted the stage for an educative talk show on the importance of the three 'Rs' of recycling which includes: Reducing, Reusing and Recycling. He spoke about the dilapidated environment we live in, and the solution which is to discourage deforestation and encourage planting of trees.

Materials for recycling were categorized into **papers, metals and plastics**. Greenhill Recycling came up with colourful activities to make the learning process more practical. The kids were divided into three groups to see which group will be able to pick more recycling materials and correctly dump them in appropriate recycling bin bags and at the end of the game, group 1 had 25 points, group 2 had 27 points and group 3 had 28 points. Gifts were given to all participants and refreshments were shared to all members of Green Hill Recycling.

### *Social Responsibility*

In line with teaching the children about social responsibility and the need to make an impact in their environment, the children picked waste materials around the venue after being grouped into paper, metal and plastic teams under the supervision of the PYP teachers and Green Hill Recycling team.
